The highs for tomorrow are in the upper 80s with lows in the upper 70s. There is a 50% chance for PM stars tonight; you'll have better luck for stars in the morning. Expect conditions to stay the same for the next couple of days until the low moves further West. Winds will be out the east at 20 knots or less and swells out of the east 8ft. or less. We are starting to experience the weather conditions for our time in Saipan. Expect highs in the upper 80s, lows in the upper 70s with a 20% of showers throughout each day.
