WEATHER FORECAST

Forecast up to arrival Kobe, Japan calls for conditions to remain as they have been for the last three days. Winds from the East averaging 10 knots or less and combined seas and swells 3 feet or less. Middle and high cloud cover could become an issue for celestial observation as we approach Japan. High temperatures will remain in the upper 80s and low temperatures in the upper 70s. Forecast models along with today's meteorology Cadets Scott and Hadley tend to agree that our stay in Kobe will bring us about 30% chance of rain each day and high and low temperatures staying the same as we have seen.
